

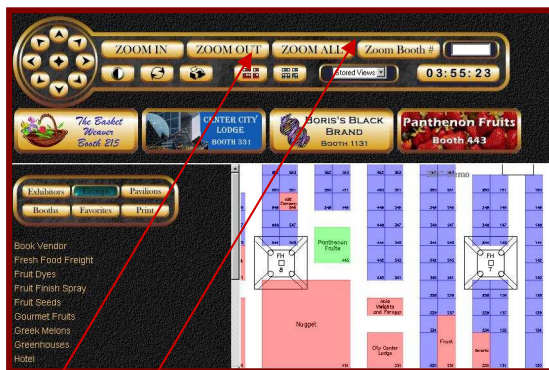
EXPOCAD VR² Viewing Instructions

Floor plans displayed in VR² are easy to navigate and will look similar to the example shown below. The show organizer may modify the buttons and color schemes, however, the basic feature functions will remain the same. Viewers must be Java[®] enabled.

The example below has sponsors icons shown that would link to a web site or their booth if they are an exhibiting sponsor. A simple click on the icon will take a viewer to an activated link.

Menu Options:

Pan Command - Simply hold mouse over arrows to move floor plan left, right, up, down or to either side.
Clicking is not necessary.



Zoom Controls

In -

In - Click to enlarge the floor plan and booths for easy reading level.

Out - Click to reduce the floor plan and booths to smaller size.

All - Click to return the floor plan to the original size.

This option fits the floor plan to the viewers screen.

Zoom Booth - Enter a booth number to jump to that booth.

Digital Clock Display may be used to track appointments for live booth sales via Internet space draw.

Stored Views - Zoom to specific areas of a floor plan such as entrances, pavilions or food courts. If list is empty, extra views are not available.

Texture Commands - **Red** highlights sold booths - Sold booths may or may not have exhibitor name in booths.

Blue highlights available booths. Available booths may also have activated links to send an e-mail to request space to show organizer. Green may indicate a Favorite booth or special sponsor.

Click and Drag Floor Plan - Simply click mouse in center of floor plan, hold and drag to any area.

↓ **Toggle** from black and white to colored floor plan. Use slide bar to right of exhibitor list to move list up or down.



← **Print** floor plan Note: Floor plan is dimensionally correct and text will not be readable if entire floor plan is printed on a single page. Zoom in for readable text before printing. Choose black and white or color.

↑ **Refresh** floor plan - may be used during live space draws to view changes.

The windows print function currently used by VR² will capture whatever view is on the monitor. For best results use high end printer. Download the latest Java for crisp, smooth colors and fonts.

The list of commands located in the left frame of VR² control what is displayed and available to view in the left frame area. A list of exhibitors is usually available and may be expanded to show more information. In the early stages, exhibitors may not be listed or tabs may be disabled.

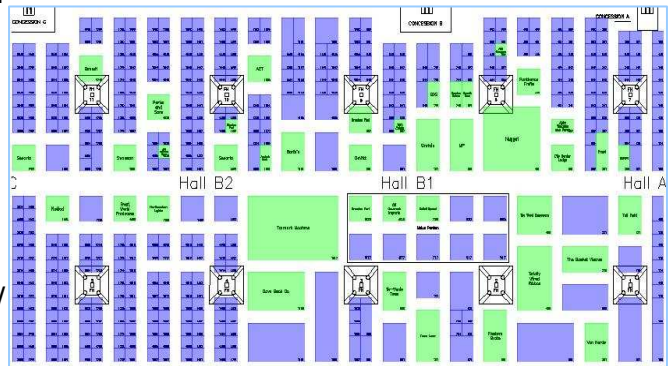
Business cards may or may not be activated under exhibitor names. Click on each name to see each expanded listing. Listings may include booth number(s), groups they belong to, main product or company description, contact, e-mail and web address. Links may go to specific locations. Business cards may also be printed.

With business card open, click on **Add Exhibitor to Favorites**. A list will continue to build as exhibitors are added. Once created, all favorites will be highlighted on floor plan in a contrasting color and may also be printed.

Groups will list a selection of exhibitors specific to their area.

Pavilions will be listed if available.

Favorites – A list of saved or favorite exhibitors or booths built by viewer is seen below and may be printed.



Once favorites are selected in the booth filter area, simply click on Highlight Booth Filter to display. Clear favorites or refresh booths displayed are also options to choose.

The **Booth Filter** shows a list of all booths, available and rented. Viewers may sort by size (area) as well. For instance, checking the 'Area' and enter = (equal) to 200 square feet. All booths matching that measurement will be highlighted.

When first opening an event, a message may appear: "Click to activate" Java®. Simply follow the directions. Depending on the internet connection speed, some floor plans may take longer to load.
